YOUR VIEWS REALLY MATTER

The survey results will help us develop a Tweedsmuir Community Action Plan that will set out community issues and priorities for action over the next 5 years.

The first Community Action Plan (CAP) prepared in 2017 has been enormously helpful in guiding the actions of the community over the last 5 years and has been used to great effect to secure a total of £880,000 funds which, along with valuable volunteer time, has enabled most of the priorities in the first CAP to be achieved.

As well as attracting funding for priority projects, the Community Action Plan has also helped the Community Council to represent the interests of the community to get things done and supported us to work in partnership and influence the work of others – such as Destination Tweed.

WHO IS CARRYING OUT THE SURVEY?

The Survey and Action Plan is being carried out by a small Steering Group of local groups and interested residents, led by the Tweedsmuir Community Company, with Community Action Planning support from STAR Development Group.

Funding for the CAP is provided by SSE Borders Community Fund.

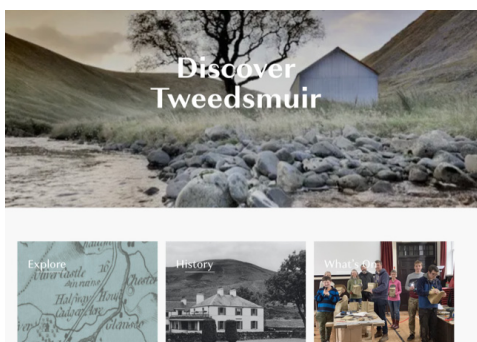

Some highlights of what has been achieved since our first CAP in 2017

REDEVELOPMENT OF THE CROOK INN

- Phase 1 well underway with the Wee Crook café opening in July
- Phase 2 funding application made for bunkhouse
- Development of the surrounding land progressing with funding secured for signage, frontage and gardens
- Phase 3 will develop a plan for the Crook building



HERITAGE, PATHS AND INTERPRETATION

- Funding for Heritage Officer – appointed in Oct 2019
- Many walks mapped, and on new Discover Tweedsmuir website, and app www.tweedsmuir.scot
- Improvements carried out to existing paths, and new paths being developed
- Interpretation and signage - ongoing
- Ecomuseum launched



ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

- Pedestrian signs between village hall and Oliver Farm
- Fruid road resurfaced
- A701 roadworks completed, and white lined

VILLAGE HALL DEVELOPMENTS & COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

- Insulation, windows and lighting – funding secured and implemented
- Funding application secured for hall heating /solar power
- Car park extension opened 2022
- Connection to mains water, and 4G broadband
- Kitchen upgrade
- New sound and film equipment
- Lots of new community activities and events!



LOCAL SERVICES

- Research and report into community minibus
- Community Council work to support transport improvements including West Linton Taxi project, Community Wheels, Upper Tweed Community Drivers, monthly Community Transport
- CC liaison with Biggar Surgery for improvements to appointments arrangements
- Two defibrillators installed.
