# **Tweedsmuir Resilient Community Register**

Time again to register and renew your details if you wish to remain on the Tweedsmuir Resilient Community Register (TRCR).

**FAQs** 

#### What is the TRCR?

This register is kept by the local community coordinator (Lesley Kirkwood) and the main aim is to coordinate available resources to deal with things like snow clearing, flooding, weather related road closures, prolonged power cuts. The list is not exhaustive, simply some examples of the sorts of things we have dealt with in the past.

#### What does it involve?

Households should provide up to date contact details and address. Please also detail what support they can offer or what support might be needed. This might be snow clearing, shopping delivered if roads are un-passable due to weather conditions eg snow/flooding or help to put sandbags out to protect property. This could mean householders who can offer help are asked if they are able to support others in the community. For further information see <a href="here">here</a>

There is no obligation to do so at any time and you will not be asked to do things that put you or others at risk. If assistance is required for something not previously identified do not hesitate to contact TRCR to see what can be done to help. ## What if my circumstances change?

Contact TRCR via email and advise of changes eg house move, access to equipment (4 x 4 vehicle/phone number has changed. This helps to keep the register up to date and aids directing resources to the right places when required.

## What else does TRCR do?

If you would like specific training and there are others also interested, there is the opportunity to access training as part of TRCR eg first aid.
