Ground Preparation:

Minimising carbon emissions and soil disturbance by planting trees direct into soil

Tree Protection:

The eastern edge of the site is already protected by a deer fence. We will create new deer fencing to cover the whole site. Individual trees to be protected with 20cm high Vole-guards and canes

Species:

Mix of native tree species of local seed provenance to provide native habitat, increase potential for biodiversity, improve water and soil quality and sequester carbon long-term

Buffer zones to be left around archaeological sites to protect the features

Existing surface stone to be quarried for a new road which will aid access and maintenance of woodland operations
